Flavors: Sapid and firmly structured with a note of freshness that is extremely pleasant

2005 Piancarda Rosso Conero

Colour: Brilliant ruby red.

Aroma complex, full, intense and persistent. Rich with scents of ripe fruit such as plums, cherries and jams.

2005 Gross Agontano

Colour: Intense, deep ruby red tending to garnet.

Flavors: Sapid, soft, warm and velvety. It features appealing sensations of jam and licorice root. Pronounced persistence.
