### 2008 Pinot Grigio "Marat"

Pinot Grigio is a mutation of the Pinot Bianco grape. The grape itself is dark yellow, slightly reddish, the berries are very small and tightly bunched together. The wine is straw-yellow in colour, very elegant in taste, broader and slightly fatter than Pinot Blanc and usually also higher in acidity. It matches well with poultry, fish, and white meats.
