2005 Vino Nobile di Montepulciano DOC

The most classic and the most famous of wines from Fattoria del Cerro. It has a vivid ruby red colour and good concentration. Intense fragrant aroma with evident fruity notes among which wild black cherry, violet and vanilla. Full balanced flavour with noticeable but discreet tannic component.

2003 La Poderina Brunello di Montalcino DOC

It has an intense ruby colour with burgundy hue and concentrated scent, enveloping, ethereal with a hint of cherry, wild berry and vanilla. The flavour is decisive, overall tannic in youth, soft and persistent. Serve at 18 degrees Celsius in large glasses and is best served with red and white meat roasts, poultry, game and aged cheese.

2001 La Poderina Brunello di Montalcino DOC 'Poggio Banale'

A bit younger and a bit less complex than the Reserve type, but nevertheless a wonderful long aged red wine. It has an intense ruby colour with burgundy hue and concentrated scent, enveloping, ethereal with a hint of cherry, wildberry and vanilla. The flavour is decisive, overall tannic in youth, soft and persistent.

2004 VINO NOBILE DI MONTEPULCIANO "VIGNETO ANTICA CHIUSINA" D.O.C.G.

Obtained from grapes of the homonymous vineyard, considered the best among the ones owned by Fattoria del Cerro. It has an intense and concentrated, vivid ruby red colour. The aroma is typical with hints of violet, wild black cherry, wild berries and touches of spices with a slight vanilla finish. It has a full, enveloping, fine and elegant flavour, with an excellent persistence.
