The colour is an intense yellow, with a long and persistent bouquet rich with scents of flowers and yellow pulpy fresh fruits, particularly peach, with a delicate finish of white pepper and vanilla. In the mouth the wine is well structured, elegant and persistent, with a well balanced acidity and freshness thanks to the period of refinement in French Allier oak barrels.

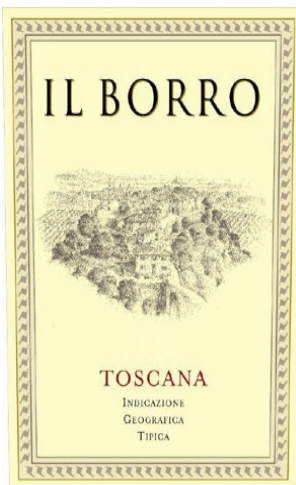
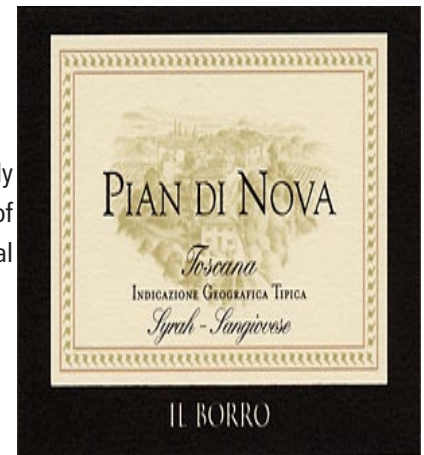


2006 Pian di Nova IGT

Pian di Nova', ruby red with purple reflections has an intense nose of spice and ripe fruit predominantly blackberry with a hint of other wild berries. On the palate it is full bodied with a good balance of warmth and tannins that compliment each other. Good persistence with a spicy, fruity finish. It is ideal for simple food and first courses. 'Il Borro' is a deep ruby red with dark purple reflections and has an intense bouquet of ripe fruit with notes of forest underbrush and spice. It is a dry, round and well-balanced wine with soft rich tannins that are consistent creating great length of finish.
