2006 Châteauneuf du Pape

Deeper purple with garnet reflections, beautiful brilliance. Aromas of black fruits, ripe marmalade. The wine evolves in the glass with an interesting woody note and licorice at the end. Well balanced wine with good concentration. Velvety and powerful with peppery notes, spice, thyme, savoury, marjoram... beautiful longer finish, finely woody.

2007 Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc

Honours are shared here between Grenache Blanc, Roussanne and Clairette, with a little Bourboulenc added, quite literally, for good measure. The Roussanne is barrel fermented and allowed to rest for four months on its lees; the result is a template of modern Châteauneuf Du Pape Blanc. This is a genuinely interesting wine, with notes of pineapple, vanillin and pear, tempered by spice, firm acidity and a balanced satisfying sensation en bouche.
